Review of Last Week

- Last week we learned that God doesn't like it when we covet or want something that doesn't belong to us; He also doesn't like it when we become jealous about what other people have.
- What was one commandment you thought about this last week, that God was maybe asking you to try to do better at? How did you do?

Review of the 10 Commandments

• The Ten Commandments are familiar to most people. Sometimes, people believe they are going to heaven just because they have not broken any of the commandments. But the truth is, we all have. Using the name of God in the wrong way, desiring to have what someone else has, making fun of parents in front of friends, and lying are all breaking one of the commandments. Unfortunately, we all have broken at least one. Everyone has failed one time or another. However, what makes us Christians is placing our faith in Jesus. Through Jesus, our sins are forgiven. Because He died on the cross for us, we have everlasting life with God. All we need to do is ask Jesus to forgive us and then work on not breaking any of the commandments again.

- Let's see if we can name all of the commandments. Can we name them in order? Well here is a list in case you need help.
 - #1. Have no other gods but God.
 - #2. Do not worship statues.
 - #3. Be careful with God's name.
 - #4. Keep the Sabbath day special.
 - o #5. Honor your father and mother.
 - #6. Do not harm others.
 - #7. Keep your promises.
 - o #8. Do not steal.
 - o #9. Do not lie.
 - #10. Do not covet.
- Great job remembering them all. I hope these will stay in your minds for a
 while, to remind us of how we need to live. Remember, that because we love
 God and have a relationship with Him, it does make following these
 commandments a bit easier. That is what our memory verse, 1 John 5:3,
 promises.
- Now we are going to go through each commandment and think back over the
 past few weeks, and talk about what it might look like to break each
 commandment, and what we need to do to make it right with Jesus, after we
 have broken the commandment.
- We are going to talk about this in our small groups; each group is going to take one or two commandments and do a presentation to the whole group. If you are by yourself, you can do this too.
- Here is the list. Make sure each group does a different one.
 - Have no other gods but God.
 - Do not worship statues.
 - Be careful with God's name.
 - Keep the Sabbath day special.
 - Honor your father and mother.
 - Do not harm others.
 - Keep your promises.
 - Do not steal.
 - o Do not lie.
 - Do not covet.
- Great work making these 10 commandments something that applies to us today. May these little presentations stay with us as well.
