## **Packing List**

As this event is overnight, there will be assigned rooms for youth to be sleeping in, separate for boys and girls. Youth are expected to bring their own bedding (pillow, blanket, sleeping bag). Below is a full list of items that students should bring:

- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Blanket
- Change of Clothes (Extra pair)
- PJ's (it's a sleepover 😊)
- Appropriate Footwear, including heavy/ warm socks
- Backpack or bag for what you are taking to West Ed.
- Swimsuit (modest swimsuits – NO bikinis, speedos)
- Towel
- Plastic bag for bringing wet swimsuit/towel back
- Other toiletries (Toothbrush/Toothpaste, Deodorant, Soap, Shampoo, conditioner, etc.)

## **Expectations while at the Waterpark**

1. Memories are made with others! Make groups! Please have at **LEAST 3** people in your group. If you go to the washroom, your friends will have to wait outside the washroom for you. **STAY TOGETHER**. This is to ensure you all are safe and accounted for.
2. Under NO circumstances are you to leave the waterpark. NO EXCEPTIONS. (obviously if they evacuate due to an emergency, follow instruction of staff...)
3. Abide by the rules and regulations of the waterpark, listening to waterpark staff at all times.
4. **At 5:00PM** please head to the change room. If you need more time to change, please go sooner.
5. **You MUST be back at the busses NO LATER THAN 5:15PM.** Please be conscious of the time. If you are unsure of the time go to the cabana and check with a leader or staff member!

## **WATERPARK FACTS**

- The world's second largest indoor waterpark (first is "Tropical Islands Resort in Germany - with a size of roughly 6 acres)
- Built in 1985 & is 4.9 acres
- It has the world's largest indoor wave pool, holding 12.3 million litres
- The wave pool has six wave bays, each with two panels with a total of 1,500 horsepower generating waves up to 5-6 meters high
- The highest slides are the Twister & Cyclone - which are 83 feet high.
- Maximum capacity of 40,000 guests
- Average temperature of the water 30-33 degrees Celsius.
