They must be self-motivated, with a continuous improvement mindset and willing to do what it takes to get the job done.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Manage the video control room equipment with regular maintenance
- Continually learning and growing knowledge with video and streaming
- Train the tech team with programing and set up as needed for special events
- Emergency troubleshooting needs as required for weekends and special events
- Find innovative ways to save money while stretching technology for what we need
- Documentation of control room equipment, signal flow and processes



An ideal candidate would have the following qualifications.

Core Skills/Experience:

- At least 3 years' experience in a Control Room Engineer, or directly related, role
- Experience in discovering and developing volunteers and staff
- Experience with leading industry switchers & routing distribution systems (Ross or equivalent) and operational frameworks (OpenGear)
- Network experience with IP-based technologies and configuration (SMPTE, NDI, Dante, IPTV) for transporting, video, audio & intercom internally
- Experience or understanding of live streaming technologies (RTSP), platforms (youtube, resi) and formats (mpeg, h.264, h.265)
- Live show production experience
- MS or industry equivalent
- AutoCad or other mapping software for video mapping
- ProPresenter and ProVideo Player programming
- Proven track record of managing video control rooms, specifically in a church environment.

Qualifications:

- Committed to living a “Jesus-shaped life”
- Understanding of what it means to be part of a church from a member and staff perspective; understanding of church culture
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to problem-solve/troubleshoot “on the fly”
- Exceptional organizational and time/self management skills
- Possess a strong curiosity to learn and ask crucial questions
- Detail-oriented and ability to complete tasks quickly and effectively
- Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to respectfully deal with conflict
