

Hello Koinonia!

Matthew 6 has some of my favourite verses in the Bible. They are not necessarily the ones I go to for my encouragement but they are where I find reminders of great ways to encourage our loving heavenly Father. Jesus says not only will these actions please your Father, but He will see them and reward you if you believe and follow this way which contradicts the way we naturally think. Take a look through the passage as you review the points below.

Matthew 6:1-18 takes 3 different looks at sneaky ways Christians can slip into pride and 4 clear ways that Jesus wants us to stay out of that subtle trap.

- 1. Don't tell people how generous you are, just be generous. Avoid letting people even see your generosity if you can (In vs. 19-34 Jesus visits a related theme of why one might be reluctant to be generous).
- 2. Don't look to impress people with your prayers. (If you look at The Message version, there is a definite attempt to make this passage relevant to our times.) Jesus follows up with the Lord's Prayer as a sample of how to pray. Think of how much it covers in so few words and notice where the focus of most of the prayer is its on who God is.
- 3. Include forgiveness in your prayers. I encourage you to dig into the reason given.
- 4. When you are giving up something for God (perhaps over lent), keep that between you and God. Think about the last time you gave up something so you could focus more on God. How did that help your relationship with Him and how you felt about yourself?

Four short thoughts for your consideration; and for mine.
