

MAIN POINT:

This Changes Everything: Tell The World!

MEMORY VERSE:

"He said to them, 'Go into all the world. Preach the good news to everyone.'" Mark 16:15

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

God sent His Son, Jesus, to earth. Jesus lived a perfect life, but then died to pay the price for our sins. He didn't stay dead! After three days He rose again! This Changes Everything: Tell the World! In our Easter story, we look at how God changed the world in an instant when Jesus died and rose again. He also changes our hearts to be more and more like Him. This is good news that we need to share with others.

In our lesson today, your family will be given the opportunity to choose to follow Jesus, and to have a relationship with Him. If someone in your family makes that decision, we want to help support you, and celebrate with you! - Crayons/pencil crayons

- Band-aid
- Feather
- Small nail
- Playdough or clay
- Popped popcorn for a treat afterwards

DO IT → COLOUR CHANGING CROSS

Sign up to receive a Ministry Box each month that includes supplies for our activities.

Supplies:

- UV colour changing pony beads (5 per child - available at Michaels)
- Coloured pony bead (1 per child)
- Suede cord (12 inches per child)
- Key ring (1 per child)
- 2 glue dots or glue gun (for parent use only!)

Activity Instructions:

- During the video, children will make the craft. Please prep the first step if you don't have a ministry box!
- Using either two glue dots, or a glue gun, attach two of the UV beads to the coloured bead as shown:



- Centre one UV bead on the piece of suede cord.
- Thread the next bead over BOTH ends of the suede cord (it will hold the first bead in place).
- Separate the ends of the suede cord, and place one end through each of the UV beads (that were shown in the picture above).
- Place the final UV bead over BOTH ends of the cord again. Tie a knot like tying a balloon, to hold in place.
- Tie onto the key ring in the same fashion.

TALK ABOUT IT:

Do this section with your child, or sign up to join our online Zoom groups, Sundays at 1:30pm.

- 1. What is something you have watched change?** (Caterpillar turn into a butterfly, seasons change outside, batter turn into cake or cookies!)
- 2. When Jesus died and rose again, He changed the whole world. This is the good news! What part of the resurrection story means the most to you?** (That even though Jesus didn't sin, He was willing to take the punishment of all the sin. That Jesus is stronger than death, stronger than anything. That God kept His promise to send a rescuer.)
- 3. Jesus wants us to Tell the World! Make a list of people you can pray for, and look for ways the share Jesus with them.** (Family members, friends from school, neighbours, people on your sports teams or in the clubs you're in, etc.)

Your child has the opportunity to collect Loaves and Fishes Dollars that they can use to buy items that will help and bless others, locally, nationally and internationally.

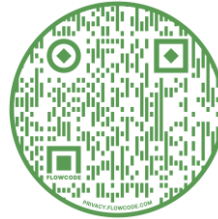
Loaves and Fishes dollars are tracked for the following:

2. To access the Online Form, use the Link or the QR Code.

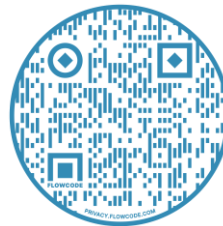

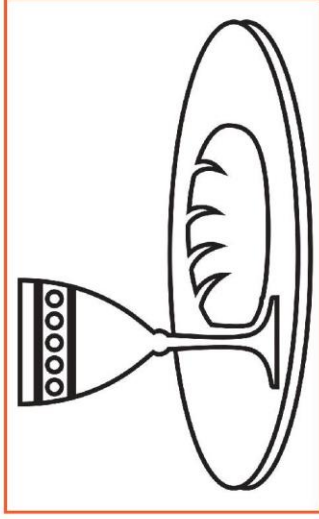
