Saturday, November 23 - Overcoming Traumatic Life Experiences - 9:30-11:30 AM, Rehearsal Room

Come join us on November 23 from 9:30 to 11:30 AM in the Rehearsal Room, at Central Campus, to hear Mia Kitteringham who is a registered counsellor and Margaret Wright who has a degree in nursing. Childhood trauma has a long-term impact on a person's life and Mia will speak from personal experience about trauma's effect on her with teaching on ACE's, Adverse Childhood Experiences, training. Margaret, a victim of crime, will provide teaching on brain functioning, the impact of PTSD on the brain, how crime affects victims, secondary trauma through blockages in the justice system, ways to address victim blaming and share examples from her healing journey. Both share practical ways to cope with trauma when it occurs, provide resources and ways to heal covering compassion fatigue and burnout.
